



Parking

Parking is simply awful during business hours in Hillsboro Village. If possible, get together with some classmates and carpool to reduce the number of cars looking for places to park.

In the map below, green indicates that it is legal to park there, red means that it is not legal to park there, and yellow means that parking is legal for only two hours.

Of course, even in the areas marked green, you must pay attention to signs and not obstruct driveways, water hydrants for fire fighters, etc. These places on the street are highly prized, and they are often full before 9 a.m.

You may see cars parked in areas marked in red. These people may have special permits to park there, because they live in the area. Just because some people can park there doesn't mean that you can park there.

Do not park in private parking areas. Illegal parking on the street usually results in a penalty of a fine, but parking in a private area may result in your car being towed away. This can be very expensive and time consuming.
